

Town of Plympton Memorial Day Parade Monday, May 25, 2009 10:00 AM

The Parade will “kick off” at 10:00 AM from Center Street onto Main Street and continue to the Town Green Gazebo. The first ceremony will take place at the Gazebo, then onto the Hillcrest Cemetery, the First Congregational Church Cemetery and conclude with refreshments at the Town House.

Please note: There has been change for staging area/line up for parade participants. Staging area will be on Center Street, the section between Main Street (near Historical Society building) and Palmer Road (new traffic signal.) All traffic dropping participants off are asked to enter and exit through the route 58/Palmer Road entrance. There will be no through traffic exiting Center Street onto Main Street due to safety procedures. Main Street will be closed from the Historical Society Building to top of Hill on Main Street. Participants may arrive at 9:00 AM to line up.
