The Plympton Public Library offers two free Digital Camera Workshops with Steven Ziglar, photographer, Saturday, May 10, from 10 a.m. to Noon, and Saturday, May 31, from 9 a.m. to noon. The workshops may be taken individually or together. There is a limit of 10 per class. Interested people may sign up at the Plympton Public Library's front desk any time prior to May 10. The first workshop will begin at the Plympton Public Library May 10, at 10 a.m. Attendees are to bring their digital cameras. Camera options will be reviews. Photo composition and lighting will be discussed. We will also review computer design programs for printing photos, cards, and bookmarks. Several artistic imaging techniques will also be explored. The class will then take a field trip to photograph two locations in Plympton.

The second workshop will also begin at the Plympton Library on May 31, at 9 a.m. Attendees are to bring their digital cameras. We will first take a field trip to photograph two locations in Plympton. We will then return to the Library to review the photos, print photos, greeting cards, and bookmarks.

Steven Ziglar has exhibited his photography in galleries in New York City and the Berkshires. His photographs of the Berkshires and Plymouth County has been featured in magazines, books, travel guides, and newspapers in the United States, Canada, England, Germany, France, Italy, Brazil, Argentina, Japan, Taiwan, and other countries.
