Francis Penney requested an extension for his project (SE266-0185) at 19 Main Street. There are no changes to the original project. Ms. Leddy made a motion that we grant Mr. Penney an extension for one year (until January 20, 2021). Ms. Nover seconded the motion. The Commission voted unanimously to approve the extension.

We also received a Building Department Request for 0 Brook Street from Borrego Solar. It was agreed that this project requires an RDA given its scope. Brian to contact Dean Smith from Borrego Solar.

The Commission had a discussion about reducing the number of people on the Commission from 7 to 5. Ms. Nover made a motion for the Plympton Conservation Commission to recommend to the Board of Selectmen that the required number of members go from 7 to 5 effective January 1, 2020, and Ms. Dion seconded. The Commission voted unanimously to accept the motion.

The Commission received a request for a letter of support to include Plympton in the MA Forest Legacy Area. This request came from The Forest Legacy Program of the Department of Conservation & Recreation. Ms. Leddy wrote a letter on behalf of the Chairman, Mr. Burnet.
