husband, Mr. Thomas SAMBSON. She died June 4th, 1799, in her
85th year of her age.

CHURCHILL R9-P12-S4
In memory of Nathaniel CHURCHILL. He died Aug. 17, 1803, aged
85 years, 3 months & 6 days.

CHURCHILL R3-P10-S10
Mary, dau. of Isaac & Hannah CHURCHILL, his wife, died Aug. 23,
1738.

CHURCHILL R1-P1-S6
Sacred to the memory of Oliver CHURCHILL, who died Nov. 24, 1851,
aged 85 years, 7 months and 3 days.
