PARKER R2-P5-S4

PARKER R2-P5-S5

Sacred to the memory of Phebe, widow of Oliver PARKER, who died Jan. 15, 1843, aged 70 years, 11 months & 10 days.

PARKER R1-P2-S13

Oliver Ames, son of Oliver PARKER, jr. & Mary P., his wife, died Oct. 30, 1835, aged 12 years, 8 months & 23 days.

PARKER R1-P4-S8

Erected in memory of Polly, wife of Jonathan PARKER, who died July 8, 1839, aged 52 years.

PARKER R2-P5-S12

In memory of Ruth, the dau. of Mr. Jonathan PARKER.

PARKER R2-P4-S8

In memory of Mrs. Ruth PARKER, wife to Rev. Jonathan PARKER, who departed this life May 17, 1745, in ye 30th year of her age.

PARKER R2-P4-S4

Erected to the memory of Mrs. Silence PARKER, wife of Lieut. Jonathan PARKER, dau. to Asaph & Mary SOULE. She departed this life March 9th, 1800, aged 25 years, 1 month & 3 days.
