SAMPSON R1-P3-S10

In memory of Miss Nancy SAMPSON, dau. of Mr. Gideon & Mrs. Lydia SAMPSON. She died Nov. 15, 1819, aged 19 years & 6 months.

SAMPSON R1-P11-S11

In memory of Obiah, widow of Mr. Zabediah SAMPSON, who died Dec. 26th ?? in her 77th year.

SAMPSON R1-P12-S9

In memory of Peleg SAMPSON, who died April 27, 1833, aged 78 years, 7 months & 1 day.

SAMPSON R1-P3-S11

In memory of Miss Sally SAMPSON, dau. of Gideon & Mrs. Lydia SAMPSON. She died Oct. 27, 1819, aged 33 years & 10 months.

SAMPSON R1-P12-S1

Sacred to the memory of Capt. Thomas SAMPSON. He died March 7, 1834, aged 86 years, 2 months & 10 days.
