Here lyes ye body of George SAMSON, who dec'd July ye 26th?? 1739 in his 87th year.

SAMSON R4-P11-35

In memory of Gideon SAMSON, who died Oct. 30, 1794, aged 75 years & 4 days.

In memory of Mrs. Hannah, widow of Mr. George SAMSON, died Sept. ye 22, 1776, aged 79 years, 6 months & 4 days.

SAMSON R4-P6-316

In memory of Mrs. Joanna SAMSON, widow of Mr. Jonathan SAMSON, who died Jan. 1, 1768, in ye 77th year of her age.

SAMSON R4-P6-315

In memory of Joanna SAMSON. She died Jan. 22, 1784, in ye 67 th year of her age.

SAMSON R4-P6-317

In memory of Mr. Jonathan SAMSON, who died Feb. ye 3rd, 1758, in ye 68th year of his age.
