Zebdiel SAMPSON of the American Army was killed in battle of Haerlem, New York. Sept. 16, 1776, aged 19 years, 5 days.

SAMPSON RI-P2-S7

This monument is erected to perpetuate the memory of Zebdiel son of Naraton and Leonice SAMPSON, who died April 6, 1820 (?) or Nov. 19, 1819 (?). ??

SAMPSON RI-P11-S12

In memory of Zebdiel SAMPSON. He was slain in Battle at (?) in 1776 in ??

SAMSON RI-P11-S10

In memory of Abigail SAMPSON, 1st wife of Zebdiel SAMPSON, who died May ye 4th, 1731.

Elizabeth SAMSON, wife to George SAMSON, who died 1727 ?? May 27, 1727

SAMSON RI-P11-S7

In memory of George SAMSON, who died Feb. 1774, in ye 83rd year of his age,

SAMSON RI-P12-S13

Here lies ye body of George SAMSON, who dee'd July ye 26th?? 1739 in his 87th year.

SAMSON RI-P11-S5

In memory of Gideon SAMSON, who died Oct. 30, 1791, aged 75 years & 4 days.

SAMSON RI-P11-S6

In memory of Mrs. Hannah, widow of Mr. George SAMSON, died Sept. ye 22, 1776, aged 79 years, 6 months & 4 days.

Here lies ye body of Isaac SAMSON, who dee'd Sept. 3, 1726, in ye 66th year of his age.

SAMSON RI-P6-S16

In memory of Mrs. Joanna SAMSON, widow of Mr. Jonathan SAMSON, who died Jan. 1, 1768, in ye 77th year of her age.

SAMSON RI-P6-S15

In memory of Joanna SAMSON. She died Jan. 22, 1784, in ye 67 th year of her age.

SAMSON RI-P6-S17

In memory of Mr. Jonathan SAMSON, who died Feb. ye 3rd, 1758, in ye 68th year of his age.
