Here lies buried Lieut. Moses STANDISH, who dec'd April ye 24th, 1769, in ye 68th year of his age.

STANDISH R4-P7-S3

Here lies buried Mrs. Rebekah STANDISH, wife of Mr. Zachariah STANDISH, jr., who died June ye 10th, 1769, aged 24 years.

STANDISH R3-P7-S10

Sacred to the memory of Sarah, dau. of Shadrach & Mary STANDISH, who dec'd Dec. 7, 1836, aged 48 years, 10 months & 5 days.
