NOTICE OF TAX CLASSIFICATION HEARING

Tuesday, December 15, 2020 at 5:00 p.m.

As required by Massachusetts General Law Chapter 40, Section 56, the Town of Plympton Board of Selectmen will hold a Fiscal Year 2021 Property Tax Classification Hearing.

Pursuant to Governor Baker's March 12, 2020 Order Suspending Certain Provisions of the Open Meeting Law, G.L. c. 30A, §18, and the Governor's March 15, 2020 Order imposing strict limitation on the number of people that may gather in one place, this meeting of the Plympton Board of Selectmen will be conducted via remote participation to the greatest extent possible. Specific information and the general guidelines for remote participation by members of the public and/or parties with a right and/or requirement to attend this meeting can be found on the Town of Plympton's website: town.plympton.ma.us

No in-person attendance of members of the public will be permitted, but every effort will be made to ensure that the public can adequately access the proceedings in real time, via technological means. In the event that we are unable to do so, despite best efforts, we will post on the Town of Plympton's website an audio or video recording, transcript, or other comprehensive record of proceedings as soon as possible after the meeting.

The purpose of the public hearing is to consider the percentages of the FY2021 tax levy to be borne by each class of taxable real and personal property. The public hearing requires a vote by the Board of Selectmen for allocation of property tax classification. All persons interested in the determination may participate and be heard at the time and place stated above.
