**A Look at the Role of Soils in a Resilient Plympton**

**Project Overview:** Plympton, MA is partnering with Southeastern Regional Planning and Economic Development District (SRPEDD), Manomet, Inc., Mass Audubon, and The Nature Conservancy to identify nature-based approaches to climate change resiliency. A series of public workshops will be held to spark local discussion of opportunities and implementation strategies.

**Soil, earth, dirt . . .** no matter what we call it, it’s the material that we build on, grow crops in, and mine resources from. While they appear to be part of an unchanging carpet in our everyday world, soils are dynamic ecosystems that provide numerous nature based services that are critical to our long-term resilience.

**SRPEDD, and Jim Newman of Linnean Solutions,** will lead a workshop on February 25 to explore: the role of healthy, functioning soils ecosystems; what does good soil health do for us; what does bad soil health do for us, and; the role of land cover and land use. Participants will also have an opportunity to learn about the forthcoming **Massachusetts Healthy Soils Action Plan.**
