Old Business:

NOI Hearing for 0 West Street opened at 7:00 pm. Ms. Dion read the legal notice from the Plympton-Halifax Express.

Joe Webby from Webby Engineering presented the project and informed the Commission that the flags have been refreshed.

Concerns are isolated wetlands and potential vernal pools which will be further assessed at the site walk.

Ms. Nover also clarified information about the FEMA boundary indicated on the plan.

DEP requested getting proof of mailing to National Heritage.

Well drill cuttings need to be disposed of properly off-site.

Mike Miksch of 172 West Street voiced concerns about the wetlands across the street. The Commission clarified that wetlands delineation is good for 3 years.
