

PLYMPTON BOARD OF SELECTMEN  
EXECUTIVE SESSION MEETING MINUTES  
October 24, 2011

Attendees: John Henry, Joe Freitas and Barry DeCristofano

The Board entered into Executive Session at 6:30 p.m. to conduct negotiations with union personnel (Purpose #2) on a motion by Mr. DeCristofano, second by Mr. Freitas. Roll call vote: Mr. DeCristofano – yes, Mr. Freitas – yes, Mr. Henry – yes

Present were representatives from the Patrolmen's Union, Officers Fowler, Teri and Mulready (Officer Mulready subsequently had to leave on a call).

Discussion centered on the Board's consideration of re-opening the current contract to modify the pay increases from 0-3-5 (percent in each of the three years) to 2-3-3, in light of the recently finalized contract with the teachers' union, which had a 2-3-3 distribution. In turn, the Board would be interested in securing concessions regarding a requirement for all officers to wear ballistic vests when on duty and a modification to sick leave usage.

The Board and the Patrolmen agreed to meet again after the Board held discussions with the Chief and the Union representatives conferred with the membership.

At 7:15 p.m., the Board voted to leave Executive Session and recess for a few minutes prior to beginning their weekly open session, on a motion by Mr. DeCristofano, second – Mr. Freitas. Roll call vote: Mr. Henry – yes, Mr. Freitas – yes and Mr. DeCristofano – yes.
