

PLYMPTON BOARD OF SELECTMEN  
EXECUTIVE MINUTES  
March 22, 2010

Attendees: Joe Freitas and Barry DeCristofano

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. and entered into Executive Session for the purpose of discussing on-going litigation in the Newcomb case (Purpose #3) on motion by Mr. Freitas, second by Mr. DeCristofano. Roll call vote: Mr. Freitas – yes, Mr. DeCristofano – yes. Mr. Karling, the Zoning Enforcement Officer was present.

Mr. Karling brought the Board up to date on the status of the case. Though the property has now been sold, it was agreed that the Town should continue to pursue seeking a judgment against Mr. Newcomb in order to recoup as much of the Town's legal costs as possible. On the motion of Mr. Freitas, second by Mr. DeCristofano, it was decided to direct Town Counsel to continue to seek a contempt of court judgment against Mr. Newcomb in the case. Vote: 2-0-0.

The Board left Executive Session and entered a recess at 6:30 p.m. to reconvene in Open Session for their regular weekly meeting at 7:00 p.m. on a motion by Mr. Freitas, second – Mr. DeCristofano. Roll call vote: Mr. Freitas – yes and Mr. DeCristofano – yes.
