

PLYMPTON BOARD OF SELECTMEN  
EXECUTIVE SESSION MEETING MINUTES  
April 30, 2012

Attendees: John Henry, Joe Freitas and Barry DeCristofano

The Board met at 7:00 PM for its regular meeting and at 8:10 PM the Board voted to go into Executive Session: on a motion by Mr. DeCristofano, second – Mr. Freitas (Roll call vote: Mr. Henry – yes, Mr. Freitas – yes and Mr. DeCristofano – yes).

The Board called an emergency meeting regarding diesel fuel storage tanks at the Sysco facility. Building Commissioner, Tom Millias and Zoning Enforcement Officer, Bob Karling were present. Mr. Millias stated that Sysco is in compliance.

**VOTED:** Motion made by Mr. DeCristofano to endorse the actions of the Building Commissioner and Zoning Enforcement Officer. Second Mr. Freitas. 3-0-0.

Town Counsel has no updates regarding the Rocky Harvest LLC case.

Mr. Henry reported that Mr. Craig Aerosmith will have a feasibility study performed on his property. Some discussion ensued regarding an low-income elderly housing versus a 55 plus community (similar to Oak Point in Middleboro) on property.

- Position to be forty hours per week.

Fire Chief, Warren Borsari:

- Donny Vautrinot will act as Fire Chief and speak at Town Meeting on Fire Department Articles.
- EMT issues – no available coverage a lot of the time.
- Discussion of salary per shift – Other communities offer \$75.00 per shift

**VOTED:** Motion made by Mr. DeCristofano to pay \$60.00 per shift and if it exceeds three hours pay for additional time. Second Mr. Freitas. 3-0-0.
