

PLYMPTON BOARD OF SELECTMEN  
EXECUTIVE and OPEN SESSION MINUTES  
May 20, 2010

Attendees: John Henry and Barry DeCristofano

The meeting was called to order at 10:40 a.m. and entered into Executive Session for the purpose of discussing the Town's position entering into contract negotiations with the Police Union (Purpose #5) on motion by Mr. DeCristofano, second by Mr. Henry. Roll call vote: Mr. Henry – yes, Mr. DeCristofano – yes.

The Board reviewed the notes from the previous meeting with the Union and discussed possibilities for the next meeting with the Union, later the same day.

1100 – Mr. Freitas is now present. Mr. Freitas was updated on the earlier discussion, and at 1200, the Union negotiators arrived (Mr. Peterson, Mr. Fowler and Mr. Costa).

The Union presented the Board reiterated their attachment to the higher education incentive aspects of the contract and presented the Board with a proposed new section of the contract that concerns alcohol and drug testing.

The date for the next negotiating session was set for 3 June at 1100.

The Board left Executive Session and adjourned on the motion of Mr. DeCristofano, second by Mr. Henry. Roll call vote: Mr. Freitas – yes, Mr. Henry – yes, Mr. DeCristofano – yes.
