


| Reinspection of Retail Food Service           | Repeat of Critical Violations, second reinspection  | Fee for second Critical Violation Reinspection \$100. Motion made, seconded and voted.  |
| Summary for new Regulation on Synthetic Drugs | This Regulation prohibits the sale, gifting, distribution or display for sale any synthetic marijuana or synthetic marijuana analogue. This Regulation applies regardless of how it is described, such as tobacco, herbs, incense, spice and other regardless of how it is being marketed for the purpose of smoking, ingesting and regardless of whether the substance is marked "not for human consumption". The penalty for violation of this regulation shall be punishable by a fine of \$1000 for the first and any subsequent violation of this Regulation.' The complete Regulation may be reviewed at the Office of the Plympton Board of Health. (address included) | Read. Motion to approve as read, seconded, voted and signed.
