Well Water issue at 266 Main Street	Testing showed lead at 266 and MTBE at 264 and both lead and MTBE at 259 Main. Resource Control has notified all residents not to drink the water. Owner of 264 stated that he has several filters in use for their house water and he does not use it unfiltered from his well. Samples for his house were not taken from the house faucets as all outside faucets are shut off for the winter.	It is noted that test samples were taken at either outside spigots or at well heads and not in house after filtering systems that are in place. Resource Controls to be requested to take drinking water samples from water lines that would be a after any filtering systems in current use.
		A check with both DEP and the CDC states that there is no danger with bathing or clothes washing using water with lead in it. Bottled water should be used for tooth brushing and drinking and cooking.
