PLYMPTON BOARD OF SELECTMEN MEETING MINUTES June 03, 2013

Attendees: John Henry, Joe Freitas and Mark Russo The Board met at 7:00 PM for its regular weekly meeting.

Ms. Linda Leddy dropped into the meeting and asked the Board to sign the acceptance gift letter from the Cole family of Carver to the Plympton Conservation Commission. The small piece of property is land locked in the middle of Cato's Ridge. Town Clerk, Ms. Tara Wick was also present and notarized the letter.

VOTED: Motion made by Mr. Freitas to accept the gift from the Cole Family. Second Mr. Russo. 3/0/0

7:00 PM APPOINTMENT: Troop 53, Life Scout, Cullen Wnek presented to the Board his Eagle Scout project of the patio plans for the Plympton Library. Library Director, Debbie Batson was present and supported Cullen's project.

The Board advised Cullen to visit the Building Department.

VOTED: Motion made by Mr. Russo to give approval to Scout Wnek to proceed with plans for the patio at the Plympton Library. Second Mr. Freitas. 3/0/0

7:15 PM APPOINTMENT: Ms. Karen Foye of Plympton and recent appointee to the Cable Advisory Board for Town brought two members of the nine member Halifax Cable Advisory Board, Mr. Richard Wright and John Mattinson. They discussed the Adelphia/Comast contract which expires in December 2013 in conjunction with the Plympton contract. The discussion was the beginning of the first meeting with the Board. The Town Coordinator had attended several meetings prior in Halifax and met with Mr. Buckley.

- Ms. Foye is responsible for the Town of Middleborough's cable network. There is **no studio**. A room in the basement at the Middleborough Town Hall is used in conjunction with the office of the IT department.
- Ms. Foye reminded the Board and Town Coordinator, that a consultant had visited the Town House and made a recommendation that the room behind the Community Meeting Room could have a camera set up with equipment for recording Selectmen meetings. The tape would then be sent to a studio for viewing. The recording would be done by a volunteer or someone they could employ for such a task.
- Silver Lake School does not have a studio
- Middleborough has a School studio
- An origination point for a "live signal" to receive broadcast information will cost Plympton approximately \$68,000.00 of which Comcast will not pay for the Town House connection or the Dennett School connection.

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- "Head End" connection for Plympton is in Plymouth.
- There is an infrastructure for an origination point along Route 58. The Town House has a cable drop. A suggestion was made; can an origination point be located at the Police Station, Fire Station, Library, Highway Department, Town House.
- Mr. Epstein is the lawyer that has worked with the Town of Halifax for the past four years in negotiating their licensing cable access contract with Comcast.
- Do not sign the Comcast draft contract. It is a "boiler plate" document and there is room for negotiations.
- One possibility is to maintain the present studio in Halifax with an increase to subscriber's at 3.5%
- Find out what the Plympton residents wants/needs are from the contract.
- Upgrade equipment to digital to replace antiquated recording machines at present Comcast studio in Halifax
- The Board asked Town Coordinator to explore two or three other options and present a written report to the Board.
- Have shorter contract terms, three to five years versus ten year contract.
- Mr. Pleau to schedule an appointment and invite Mr. Buckley to meet with Board and present members to discuss Comcast contract.
- Set up as a Non-Profit.
- Mr. Russo suggested other alternatives be explored by Mr. Pleau.

8:00 PM APPOINTMENT: Mr. and Mrs. Charles Burns of Lake Street presented the Board with a flyer for an August 24 to 25, 2013 fund raiser. Also present at the meeting was the Board of Health, Chairman Doyle and Fire Chief Borsari. Mrs. Burns stated that she spoke with Police Chief Dillon as well. The Board advised Mr. and Mrs. Burns to visit with the Board of Health and Zoning Board for their guidelines on the event.

VOTED: Motion made by Mr. Russo to have Chairman Henry sign the MLB CPA. LLP certified Public Accountants and Advisors for the Town contract for the years ending June 30, 2013, 2014, and 2015. Second Mr. Freitas. 3/0/0

Mr. Freitas commented that he will contact the organizers of the Best Buddies Challenge bike ride that took place on Saturday, June 02, 2013. His concern being that four bicycle's riding abreast Route 58 may cause an accident.
