Budget Requests:

Town Clerk, Tara Wick:

Next year the town clerk will likely be a certified Mass Municipal Clerk and the salary usually increases by \$1,000. She is seeking to add 5 hours to the assistant clerk's work week, bringing it to 20 hours. Budget increase reflects 3 upcoming elections. Mailing costs have decreased due to the use of a new mailing option.

Police Chief, Patrick Dillon:

He said it is difficult to determine annual salary projections due to evening differentials, educational incentives, holidays, personal days, etc. He is currently estimating a 2% increase in salaries but they are currently in negotiations and we await the outcome. He is requesting a 9th officer so that there will be 2 officers on every shift.

Next year he will request \$2,500 for the DARE officer since the drug seizure funds currently paying this person are running out.

New Business:

Preliminarily reviewed the current revenue projections, budget and capital requests. There is a significant shortfall. For the next meeting it was agreed to review all budgets minus any additional personnel and with salary increases at 2% to see what those numbers yield.

We were scheduled to meet with the Board of Selectmen but they were not in session.
