Budget: Met with FinCom. request for budget to be revised. Deb prepared a "worst-case" budget: (2% payroll, level fund all other items...loss of programming, travel expenses) SAILS and materials expense are set increases. 1.23% increase overall.

VOTED: Board voted to submit the revised budget as requested by the Finance Committee in the amount of \$127,568

"Panic Button": Proposal/Estimate for Basic and a more complete system (motion detectors also). Deb will contact the people who do the smoke alarm to get a comparative proposal.

Building: New rug delivered! Looks beautiful. Table on its way.

Exterior painting: hopeful that crew will be here in spring. Emailed Field Supervisor.

Bird in the building...not sure how it got in.

Landscaping: Norfolk Aggie contacted by V. Maloney. They were very interested and are drawing up plans, may help with actual planting.
