## PLYMPTON BOARD OF SELECTMEN MINUTES February 11, 2013

7:00 PM APPOINTMENT: Conservation Commission, Open Space Committee, Community Preservation Commission

The Community Meeting Room was full to capacity for the meeting. Many residents attended the meeting for companionship and warmth, as well as attending the 7:00 PM appointment. The Town was still without electrical power since Friday, February 8, 2013 from the Blizzard Nemo. The Town House generator was supplying electrical power to the Town House offices in order for the meeting to take place.

There were several different Committees and Members in attendance at the Selectmen Meeting. Ms. Linda Leddy of the Conservatin Commission and Open Space Committee gave a presentation on the Churhill Park Site. Ms. Leddy requested an extension on the Purchase and Sales agreement due to an unexpected obscure IRS hold on the land. Ms. Leddy noted that the "Church Hill Park at the Jones River Brook" is actually 10.8 acres.

Ms. Leddy presented:

- A handout to Board "Draft Outline of Permitting Process for Churchill Park
- Budget Churchill park implementation
- Original Second Amendment to Purchase and Sale Agreement, ----, 2013 (June 06, 2012 and extended by mutual agreement on August 6, 2012) on file in Selectmen's Office
- State GIS maps gave more clarity to the topography of land
- Town Committees have been actively communicating with Mass Endangered Species Act, Department of Environmental Quality and Americans With Disabilities Act regarding compliance with Local and State regulations
- The Churchill Park area is not within a conserved area on the MESA map and will not have to go through the National Heritage Program for permitting
- Expert consultants will aide in the laying out of trails and building the board walk
