The Town of Plympton Planning Board met June 22, at the Plympton Town House, Planning Room, at 7 p.m. Present were Irving Butler, Chairman; Deborah Anderson, acting secretary; and John Rantuccio, member. Not in attendance was William McClellan.

There was no business to come before the board.

A carpenter stopped in to see if the front porch project he was working on at the home of George and Sandra Colby, 380 Main Street, needed review by the Planning Board. He had neither photograph nor plan of any kind, but described the project as rebuilding an existing front porch, which would have an extra foot in length more than the former structure, but would not extend beyond the existing home. Chairman Butler said that if it didn't cause the porch to violate side boundary setbacks, then the Planning Board didn't need to get involved.

Having no other business to be heard, the board adjourned at 7:40 p.m.
