

Plympton Planning Board meeting 7-11-16

Present: Chairman Irving Butler, Deborah Anderson, and Paul D'Angelo. Absent were William McClellan and John Rantuccio.

We will next meet July 25, at the Town House, at 7 p.m.

Plympton Planning Board met Monday, July 11, 2016 at 7 p.m

Chairman Irving R. Butler called the meeting to order at 7 p.m.

The first order of business was to pay engineer John Chessia \$605 for his work on the Lake Street solar array. Motion by Anderson, second D'Angelo, the motion carried.

Joe Shanahan, representative from Clean Energy Collective, brought a sample decommissioning clause for the solar array at 190 Brook St. After discussion, Anderson moved to accept the proposal from Clean Energy, which requires a new engineering valuation for the decommissioning proposal every five years, and an adjustment made on the bond reflecting the new estimate. D'Angelo seconded, the vote was unanimous.

Discussion ensued regarding the continued absence of John Rantuccio from the board. Review of the past minutes show that he has been absent for the past 7 months, all but 2 meetings. The board agreed to email him and request his intentions regarding his position on the board and whether he intends to continue.

Paul D'Angelo moved that Chairman Butler be allowed to sign the pay warrants for the assistant Kathy Wright, so that her pay not be held up because of lack of quorum on the Board. Anderson seconded, and the motion carried unanimously.

Discussion concerning decommissioning for the Blue Wave Lake Street solar array. The Blue Wave representative sent a proposal which the Planning Board did not agree with. Chairman Butler will invite them to come before the board at our next meeting, July 25, to discuss it.

Anderson moved to adjourn at 8 p.m. D'Angelo seconded. Motion carried.

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
