By roll call vote the BOS adjourned to Executive Session (MGL 30a §21) to discuss Purpose 2. Vote 3/0.

- Jon Wilhelmsen updated the BOS of the restoration project for the Bandstand on the Town Green.
- Highway Superintendent Scott Ripley and BOS discussed the speed limit survey completed in the 70's. BOS discussed possibility of having the default speed limit set to 30 for the Town to help protect and maintain the Town's character and improve public safety. BOS will request OCPC to complete a traffic study for the portion of Main Street that is now posted at 45mph. Mr. Ripley presented a request to have transfer station sticker fees. The BOS affirms the supports the increase of the transfer stickers for homes based on dwelling units.
