Fees: Payable by check, money order (payable to the TOWN OF PLYMPTON), credit card or cash (exact cash only).

RECYCLE ONLY Sticker: \$30.00 (Allows use of ONLY recycle areas – NO household refuse)

LIMIT OF TWO STICKERS PER HOUSEHOLD

Vehicle registration required to purchase sticker(s)

Proof of residency may be required to purchase stickers. i.e.: phone bill, utility bill, lease, etc.

Fee prorated for NEW residents only.

STICKER AND BAG SALES: (VEHICLE REGISTRATION REQUIRED FOR STICKERS!)

2024 Stickers and bags will be **sold at the Highway Department office**, 23 Palmer Road; phone 781-585-3703 **starting January 2, 2024** during the following hours:

Monday, Wednesday and Thursdays 9:00AM – Noon Saturday (January 6 – April 6) 9:00AM – Noon NO SATURDAYS from April 13 through December 31

Other arrangements may be made by calling the Highway Dept. office during the above times

Stickers must be permanently attached to drivers' side rear window, lower left-hand corner. Any sticker that is not permanently attached will be considered null and void and access to Transfer Station may be denied.

Plympton is a PAYT (Pay as you throw) community. All Household trash must be in Town bags for disposal. Bags are sold at Shaw's/Carver, Aubuchon/Carver, Market Basket/Plymouth, Plympton Convenience & Liquor Store and Plympton Highway Dept.

RESIDENTIAL HOUSEHOLD TRASH ONLY and EACH HOUSEHOLD USING THE FACILITY MUST HAVE A VALID STICKER (even if someone else brings your trash in) All household trash must be bagged in Town of Plympton bags.

Failure to comply with these rules may result in the loss of Transfer Station privileges.

RECYCLING INFORMATION

Plympton requires everyone to recycle!

The Town of Plympton would like to thank all residents in advance for their cooperation in recycling every applicable item in the proper locations.

Please place the following items in the designated areas:

#1. Cardboard and Paper: deposit in cardboard/paper compactor (no books)

Remove all Styrofoam, bubble wrap, plastic bags

Flatten all boxes before depositing into compactor

Note: Books should be placed in the general refuse compactors – not recyclable

#2. Commingles: (Glass bottles, #1 thru #7 plastic bottles): Place in commingle compactor

Rinse/clean all containers, remove all caps and dispose of with commingles The following glass products are NOT recyclable: window glass, glass blocks, china dinnerware, Pyrex and ceramics. These go in the household rubbish compactors In Town bags

#3. Scrap Metal: in scrap metal container, including washers, dryers, stoves, water heaters, microwaves and clean tin cans.

<u>Please note</u>; items #4 thru #8 must be paid for by check made out to the Town of Plympton. Please see attendant prior to using these.

- #4. Bulk Dumpster: <u>Charge for all items</u> –<u>attendant must be present when depositing items.</u> (No metal products, demolition/construction materials)
- #5. TV's, Monitors, Computers, Printers/Scanners & Office Equipment, Air Conditioners, Dehumidifiers (\$15 fee): in the Electronic recycling container –please see attendant first
- **#6. Refrigerators, Freezers, (\$15 fee):** in the Appliance recycling container please see attendant first
- **#7. Mattresses & Box Springs (\$50 fee each piece):** in the Mattress/Box Spring recycling container please see attendant first
- **#8. Tires NO RIMS** Auto & smaller, \$8.00; 19.5", \$10;00; Truck, \$20.00; Tractor trailer \$30.00; Small farm tractor tire \$40.00; Large rear farm tractor \$85.00; Loader Tire \$450.00
- **#9. Clothing & Shoes:** in the Salvation Army bins
- #10. UNIVERSAL WASTE SHED: please deposit in the proper container(s).

 NO CHARGE FOR THE FOLLOWING; Batteries: Lithium and Lead only, Auto batteries.

 Lightbulbs: Fluorescent and CFL's only. Mercury products: Thermometers,

 Thermostats & liquid Mercury
- **#11. Returnable bottles & cans:** in the bottle dumpster, proceeds donated to the Dennett School children 6th grade class

If you have any questions regarding where something goes, please ask an attendant. With help from you, we can keep the household refuse disposal costs to a minimum!

- √ HOUSEHOLD trash must be in Town bag
- ✓ CARDBOARD, must be flat before dumping
- ✓ MERCURY PRODUCTS, see attendant
- ✓ PLASTIC/GLASS, clean, remove caps/lids
- ✓ **REDEEMABLE CANS/BOTTLES,** clean, proceeds donated to Dennett School children 6th grade class
- ✓ **METAL ITEMS**, no charge
- ✓ **PROPANE TANKS**, no charge please see attendant
- ✓ MEDICINE Deposit in the container in the lobby of the Police Station. Keep in original container, leave name of medication on bottle/container, black out personal info.

WE ACCEPT SHARPS

Sharps must be in our approved containers which are available FREE to residents (limit one container at a time). Bring in a full container and receive a new empty container.
