Saturday 9:00 am to 4:45 pm sharp, & Sunday, 9:00 am to 11:45 am sharp

CLOSED Monday, Wednesday, Friday, & holidays

2014 Fees: Payable by check, money order (payable to the TOWN OF PLYMPTON) or credit card only. No cash accepted.

Residents: \$200.00

Senior Citizens 65 or older: \$ 100.00*

Second sticker: \$ 10.00

LIMIT OF TWO STICKERS PER HOUSEHOLD

Vehicle registration required to purchase sticker(s)

Proof of residency may be required to purchase stickers. ie: phone bill, utility bill, lease, etc.

* In order to receive the senior rate, the senior must be the owner of record of the Plympton property

Fee prorated for NEW residents only.

RECYCLE ONLY Sticker: \$30.00 (Allows use of ONLY recycle areas – NO household refuse)

STICKER SALES: VEHICLE REGISTRATION REQUIRED!

Stickers sold at the Highway Department office, 23 Palmer Road; Phone 781-585-3703

January thru April: Tuesday's from 2 pm to 5 pm, Thursday's from 5 to 7 pm and Saturday's from 9 am to 2 pm.

May thru December: Tuesday's and Thursday's from 2 pm to 5 pm and Friday from 9 am to 12 noon.

Other arrangements may be made by calling the Highway Dept. office during the above times

Stickers must be permanently attached to drivers' side rear window, lower left hand corner. Any sticker that is not permanently attached will be considered null and void and access to Transfer Station may be denied.

Please remove old stickers prior to attaching new sticker to vehicle.

RESIDENTIAL HOUSEHOLD TRASH ONLY and EACH HOUSEHOLD USING THE FACILITY MUST HAVE A VALID STICKER (even if someone else brings your trash in)

All household trash must be bagged.

Failure to comply with these rules may result in the loss of Transfer Station privileges.

MATERIALS NOT ACCEPTED AT THE TRANSFER STATION:

Commercial or construction debris, brush, logs, stumps, chemicals, medical and nuclear waste, waste oil, antifreeze, solvents, gasoline, naphtha, etc.

**NO CONTRACTORS, COMMERCIAL or BUSINESS DUMPING ALLOWED –
HOUSEHOLD REFUSE ONLY!**

RECYCLING INFORMATION

Plympton requires everyone to recycle!

The Town of Plympton would like to thank all residents in advance for their cooperation in recycling every applicable item in the proper locations.

Please place the following items in the designated areas:

#1. Cardboard and Paper: deposit in cardboard/paper compactor (no books)

Remove all Styrofoam, bubble wrap, plastic bags

Flatten all boxes before depositing into compactor

Note: Books should be placed in the general refuse compactors – not recyclable

#2. Commingles: (Glass bottles, #1 thru #7 Plastic bottles): Place in commingle compactor

Rinse/clean all containers, remove all caps and rings

The following glass products are NOT recyclable: window glass, glass blocks, china dinnerware, Pyrex and ceramics. These go in the household rubbish compactors

#3. Scrap Metal: in scrap metal container, **including clean tin cans**

Please note; items #4 - #8 must be paid for by check only, made out to the Town of Plympton. No cash accepted. Please see attendant.

#4. Bulk Dumpster: Charge for all items –attendant must be present when depositing items. (No metal products, demolition/construction materials)

#5. TV's, Monitors, Computers, Printers/Scanners & Office Equipment (\$15 fee): in the Electronic recycling container – please see attendant first

#6. Refrigerators & Freezers, Air Conditioners, Microwaves etc (\$10 fee): in the Appliance recycling container – please see attendant first

#7. Mattresses & Box Springs (\$20 fee each): in the Mattress/Box Spring recycling container – please see attendant first

#8. Tires: NO RIMS – (Small \$5, Large \$10) - pay attendant first

#9. Clothing & Shoes: in the Salvation Army bins

#10. UNIVERSAL WASTE SHED: deposit in the proper container(s).

NO CHARGE FOR THE FOLLOWING;

Batteries: Alkaline, NiCad, Lithium and Cadmium in the Universal Waste Shed

Auto batteries: in the Universal Waster Shed

Lightbulbs: Fluorescent, CFL's, in the Universal Waste Shed

Mercury products: Thermometers, thermostats in the Universal Waste Shed

#11. Returnable bottles & cans: in the bottle dumpster, proceeds donated to the Dennett School children

If you have any questions regarding where something goes, please ask an attendant. With help from you, we can keep the household refuse disposal costs to a minimum!

WE ARE NOW ACCEPTING FURNITURE, MATTRESS/BOX SPRINGS, RUGS. RUG PADS, SINKS & TOILETS.

FEES FOR SUCH ITEMS ARE LISTED BELOW, PAYMENT BY CHECK ONLY ~ NO CASH ~ Checks made out to TOWN OF PLYMPTON

SEE ATTENDANT FOR PRICING OF ALL ITEMS NOT LISTED

- ✓ **HOUSEHOLD** trash must be bagged
- ✓ **CARDBOARD**, must be flat before dumping
- ✓ **MERCURY PRODUCTS**, see attendant
- ✓ **PLASTIC/GLASS**, clean, remove caps/lids
- ✓ **REDEEMABLE CANS/BOTTLES**, clean, no caps/lids proceeds donated to Dennett School
- ✓ **METAL ITEMS**, no charge
- ✓ **PROPANE TANKS**, 20 lbs, no charge
- ✓ **MEDICINE** – Keep in original container, leave name of medication on bottle/container, black out personal info; **PILLS**, add water or soda to dissolve, cap tightly and seal with tape, put in trash; **LIQUIDS**, add kitty litter, coffee grounds or dirt to the liquid medicine, cap tightly and seal with tape, put in trash

TIRES, \$5 small w/o rim; \$10 large w/o rim

APPLIANCES, \$10 washer/dryer, stove, water heaters, refrigerators, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, microwaves

TV'S, \$15, **COMPUTER PARTS**, \$15 monitors, towers

COUCH, \$15; **SOFABED**, \$20; **LOVESEAT**, \$10

UPHOLSTERED CHAIR, \$10; **RECLINER**, \$15

KITCHEN/DINING CHAIR, \$5; **OTTOMON** \$5; **TABLES**, \$10

kitchen/dining; \$5 end table/coffee table; nightstand

BUREAU, \$10 large, \$5 small

MATTRESS, \$20, **BOXSPRING**, \$20;

RUGS & CARPETING, \$10; **PADDING**, \$5

MISCELLANEOUS; sink \$7, toilet \$12

ITEMS NOT ALLOWED:

- **Demolition**, no construction debris, wood/plaster board
- **Hazardous materials**
- **Oil Based Paints**, Latex accepted if solidified
